## END OF 2ND TERM, 2024/2025 SESSION

### JS3 and SS3 classes will be staying Back!

With the official departure of our students for Easter Break on Saturday 12th April, 2025, we mark the end of our second term. However, as the rest of the classes go on holidays, JS3 and SS3 classes will be staying back in school to prepare and commence their final WAEC/NECO Examinations.

### Holiday Project/Feedback Forms

Parents and Guardians should ensure that their children/wards complete all holidays' Projects/Assignments while at home as such will be submitted at the registration points as they return to school. The feedback forms should be completed strictly and signed by Parents/Guardians. Students who default will be made to serve one week of punishment.



## RESUMPTION FOR 3RD TERM

All the students will return to school on Saturday 3rd May 2025, while lessons will commence on Tuesday 6th May 2025. Parents/Guardians whose children/wards for any reason will not return within the opening date should formally notify the Principal as defaulters will not be accepted into the school.

## MID-TERM BREAK

The 3rd term mid-term break runs from Saturday, 14th June to Friday, 20th June 2025. All students—except JSS3 and SS3—must return on Saturday, 21st June 2025. Parents who wish for their children to remain in school during the break must pay **₦25,000** for upkeep, alongside the 3rd term fees.

## EVALUATION

### Second Term Results

### Remedial Classes

Management will review the effect of the remedial classes to see the level of improvement among those who took part in the exercise at the end of the second term. Students who may still require the services by the third term will have their parents/guardians duly notified after resumption.



## NEW SCHOOL SHOES FOR BOYS

The Management after a review of the school shoes for boys, found out that the quality and design were very poor. Therefore, a new, stronger and better designed shoe is already introduced. It is still sold at the same amount like the old one. Those whose old shoes are good can still be using them until the end of this session. By the beginning of next session in September 2025, all old shoes will be phased out.

Students are advised to use only Kiwi type of polish with brush to shine their shoes, liquid polishes are no long allowed as they aid in damaging the leather shoes
